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### Cakes Fit for Kings

The holiday season may have seemingly come and gone. But for those who mark Three Kings Day (Wednesday), the feast is just beginning, so to speak.

A number of New York restaurants and bakeries are offering items traditionally associated with the holiday, otherwise known as the 12th day of Christmas. In France, the almond-filled galette des rois, or king cake, is the dessert of choice. Choc O Pain ([chocopainbakery.com](http://chocopainbakery.com)), a French bakery with locations in Hoboken and Jersey City, N.J., sells a version that serves six for \$27.95; the item will be offered through the end of January.

And in Latin America, the rosca de reyes, is another king cake, typically decorated with candied fruit. Fonda ([fondarestaurant.com](http://fondarestaurant.com)), a Mexican restaurant with locations in the East Village, Chelsea and Park Slope, is featuring a version for two (\$15) on its dessert menu through Jan. 10. The cake is offered with complementary Mexican-style hot chocolate.
